**REP. KANE JOINS WESTBOROUGH LEGISLATORS IN SECURING ADDITIONAL
LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THE TOWN OF WESTBOROUGH**

(BOSTON)- Representative Hannah Kane, (R-Shrewsbury), joined her colleagues, Representative Danielle Gregoire (D-Marlborough) and Representative Carolyn Dykema (D-Holliston) in passing a home rule petition to grant an off-premise liquor license to the 7-11 located at 2 South Street in Westborough.

“I am pleased to have co-sponsored this piece of legislation along with my colleagues in the Westborough Delegation,” said Representative Kane. “As a result of this legislation being signed into law, the small business owner of Westborough’s 7-11 franchise can now offer his prospective customers a broader array of products at this convenient location. “This off-premise liquor license will allow our local owner to grow his business, remain competitive, as well as serve the demand that has been created by Westborough’s increasing residential population and growing commercial workforce,” said Representative Gregoire, who as the Representative for this Precinct 3 business, served as the lead sponsor of this bill. "Cooperation between employers, local officials, and state legislators is essential to supporting local businesses in our community," said Representative Dykema.
